


Every end has a new beginning!



Bal Panchayat Elections recently held at the Bal Ashram-Rehabilitation Centre

Let your voice be heard- Vote!

While all of us at Bal Ashram were shivering in the December winter waves in Rajasthan, we were captivated to witness the enthusiasm of children representing different parties at the recent Bal Panchayat (Children's Council) Election held at Bal Ashram. 17 children contested for the elections out of which 12 were selected as members of the children's council. These children campaigned in the Bal Ashram campus, designed and distributed their party pamphlets, and were seen convincing other children to cast their vote for them.

Bal Panchayat is a platform that gives children a unique opportunity to voice out and share their ideas freely. Such initiatives are extremely helpful in boosting children's confidence and further promoting their participation in democratic decision–making. You would be delighted to see some pictures where our co–founders Nobel Laureate Kailash Satyarthi and Smt Sumedha Kailash are encouraging children and chanting child rights slogans with them during the Elections.

Another child Kabir (name changed) said it was my first time as the representative, I enjoyed this process of election, I want to fight against child labour as a minister and this is the first step towards it."

Reopening of the Vocational Training Centre for Women





'We are excited and happy to be back- a voice that keeps echoing at the Balika Ashram, where young girls from nearby banjara communities and villages walk in every morning to their stitching and tailoring classes organized at our Vocational Skill Training Centre. It is invigorating to know that most of the girls who have completed their 6-month-training with us, are now either teaching some of their friends/siblings or have opened a small shop with a tailoring machine to earn and meet their daily financial needs. Currently, 15 girls have been regularly attending the classes.

Radhika from the centre shared" My sisters and aunts ask me to stitch blouses for them and they pay me back for my work, it feels so empowering."

Mental Health at Bal Ashram

19 children received mental health counseling from a dedicated team of counselors at the Department of Mental Health and Behavioral Sciences (Fortis Healthcare). The counselors from Fortis and Bal Ashram are using a variety of therapeutic techniques including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Interpersonal Therapy, and Art Therapy to enhance the overall well-being of children at Bal Ashram.

"I do not fight with Akhil (name changed) anymore. We are friends!" Whenever I feel angry, I use the technique didi has asked me to do. It works like magic!! Akash (name changed) from Bal Ashram mentioned to us in his recent conversation with our in-house counselor. It is soothing for us to observe such positive change among children and how they are gradually learning to regulate their emotions and control anger.





M-learning for children at Bal Ashram

Since the beginning when schools moved online amid the pandemic, we at Bal Ashram switched to the online mode of teaching and explored ways to ensure children do not miss out on their regular classes. The partnership between Bal Ashram Trust, BYJU's, and HMD Global has been rewarding in terms of providing constant support to children for continuing their education through online mode.

18 children from grades 9 to 12 continued their online formal education through Nokia smartphones. Children are thrilled to learn from the interactive learning material provided to them that includes, different types of fun puzzles, general knowledge quizzes, and NCERT multiple-choice questions that the children learn in the M-learning classes.

Visit to our Banjara Education Centres

And that's what we call expressing mixed emotions- there were smiles, laughter, and tears in the eyes of people from Banjara communities from village Bansoor when they met Smt. Sumedha Kailash and Nobel Laureate Shri Kailash Satyarthi after almost 2 years who they fondly call Matai Ji and Bhaisahab.







The pandemic has delayed their physical meeting with the community however the enthusiasm and zeal of the community to meet their leaders were incredible. Women and children from the Banjara community greeted and danced with them on the tunes of their traditional Banjara songs.

A woman from the Majara Rawat shared "I am so grateful to meet Bhabhi Ji and Bhaisahab Ji today, they have been a constant source of inspiration for all of us in the village. My children today are now enrolled in the Government school only because of their support."

Capacity Building Workshops for Teachers from Banjara Education Centres

To strengthen the functioning of our Banjara Education Centres, an intensive two-day teacher training program was organized at the Bal Ashram campus. Our flagship program- Banjara Education Centre has played a pivotal role in creating first-generation learners from Banjara Communities of Rajasthan. To further enhance the capacities of the teachers from these centres, the training was conducted by using an interactive training module that guided them on the importance of child development and enabling child-friendly classrooms for children.





Constitution of Bal Panchayat

After the election of Bal Panchayat held in our 10 BMG got over the last month, the process of the constitution of Bal Panchayat began; recognition from Gram Panchayat is an important step to certify Bal Panchayat as a legitimate institution of villages. We were contented to be a part of the pledging ceremony of Bal Panchayat members in the presence of Head- Gram Panchayat of each village. All the



110 elected Bal Panchayat children received recognition certificates along with guidelines of their roles and responsibilities.
